

ADOPTION BODY LAUDED

Mayor Speaks at Dedication of Spence-Chapin Building

A new headquarters for Spence-Chapin Adoption Service was dedicated yesterday at 6 East Ninety-fourth Street.

At the ceremonies, Mayor Wagner congratulated the agency for its accomplishments in finding new homes for children, and for placing them at the earliest possible age. "The city appreciates the work you are doing," he said.

Mrs. Eric H. Haight, president of the service, read letters of commendation from Mrs. Dwight D. Eisenhower and Governor Harriman.

The agency moved to its new address last August from 304 East Thirty-third Street. In the new quarters, it occupies a remodeled thirty-room, five-story building.
