The Special Needs Adoption Program places medically fragile children with permanent, loving adoptive families who can care for their ongoing needs.

## THIS PROGRAM

- Finds homes for babies and children with complex medical challenges, including rare genetic syndromes and short life expectancies
- 100% of all placements have been permanent, with no disruptions
- Offers counseling, support, and legal counsel to birth parents
- Provides trained volunteer interim families to care for children 24/7 as they await their forever families
- Covers the cost of all medical procedures and treatments needed before placement
- Ensures adoptive families receive medical training and are connected to local resources
- Is a recipient of the the Angel in Adoption® Award from the Congressional Coalition on Adoption Institute, at the recommendation of U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand

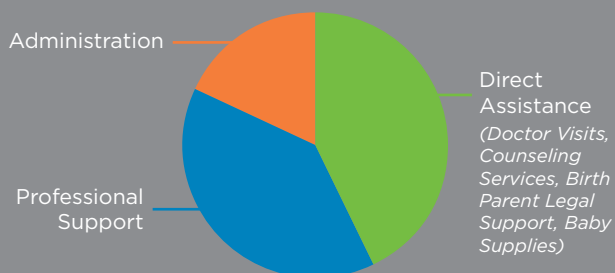

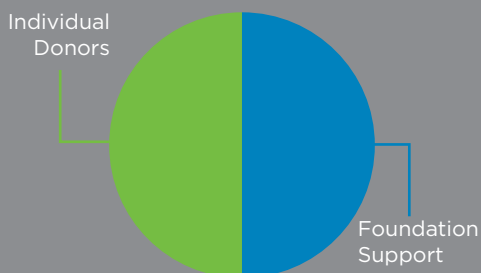

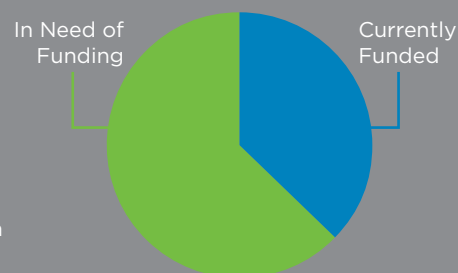
